I have attached a few pictures for you. My favorite is the one of Lucy running with the ears flapping in the air. She is the most loving dog I have ever seen. She has



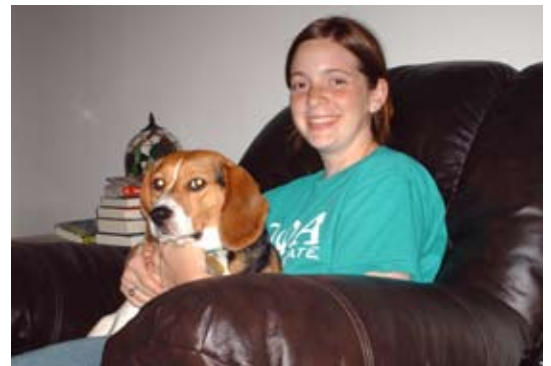

Dog Treats From Your Kitchen

Christmas Mint Cookies *From: <http://www.robinsfyi.com>*

1 1/2 cups whole wheat flour
1 1/2 cups bisquick
1/2 cup mint chopped leaves
1/4 cup milk
4 tablespoons margarine
1 egg
1 1/2 teaspoons corn syrup

1. Combine all ingredients in food processor, process until well mixed
2. Roll out on a floured surface to 1/4 to 1/2 inch thickness.
3. Cut with holiday shaped cookie cutters, place on non-stick cookie pan.
4. Bake at 375 F for 20 minutes or until lightly browned.
5. Cool and store in air-tight container.
